

- 1. The Garden Committee is comprised of all active gardeners during the annual gardening season. Gardeners may bring any issues before the committee for discussion and resolution by majority vote with right of appeal to the Conservancy Board.
- 2. Dates relating to gardening season:
 - Mid-Feb.: notice to community regarding opening of applications.
 - Mid-April: Garden Chair begins assigning plots to those who have submitted applications and paid fees. Lottery held if there are more applicants than available plots.
 - Mid May: Ending date for refunds to any gardener's opting out
 - Memorial Day weekend: Lottery for gardeners wishing second plots if any are available.
 - Oct sign up for returning gardeners. This allows to keep original plot and planting of spring bulbs, garlic etc.
- 3. All pesticides, fertilizers, Preen and or amendments to soil etc. shall be organic.
- 4. Water spigots turned off and gate locked after each use.
- 5. Children must be supervised by an adult gardener.
- 6. All tools shall be stored in the tool shed and locked after each use. No tools to be left in the garden.
