## Scarlet Lane

Clear the maple branches away from #3 Heavily reduce and shape the river birch between 3 & 5 in rear Clear the maple on right front of 13 Clear the sycamore left front of 19 Clear the sycamore away from front of 23 Reduce and shape the white pine in the rear between 12-14 and clear sycamore away from front Clear the birch away from left rear of 10 Reduce the white pine to clear the right rear of unit 8 Clear the birch away from left rear of 6 Reduce and shape white pine right rear of 4 Clear the mulberry away from the rear of 2-4 Reduce and shape the white pine to clear left side of 2 <u>Marble Fawn</u>

# Shorten back maple branches right front of 7

Clear crabapple away from front of 15

Reduce and shape white pine rear between 19 & 21

Clear crabapple away from front of 25

Clear the crabapple away from front of 29

Clear the branches away from front left of 33
