- 10 Scarlet: Tom overviewed the remediation situation at 10 Scarlet and assured that no Duplex were being utilized. - **19 Marble Faun, leaking basement.** Two proposals were presented and read by Tom to the homeowner, Milna and Robert. Budget Dry proposal appeared to only cover one of the two cracks and the work description was not impressive.

- 2. For exterior digging, is the replacement of landscaping included
- 3. When you were at the site, you mentioned the electric box to the homeowner, but did not include it in the proposal.

Tree trimming: Tom reviewed the Evergreen Contract for \$6250, street by street This list can be found as addendum #1

Tom presented all in attendance the importance of good financial management. Every \$1100 of for any and every reason could equate to a \$1 per month raise in Duplex council fees, unless an equal savings in budget could be found elsewhere. Also the importance of Increasing the Duplex reserves to prevent assessments in the future

Insurance: Is there such a insurance policy that can be purchased that can be used for large assessments. Tom and Diane Corcoran will look into this.

Budgets Overview. Tom presented an overview of how the \$353 monthly fee is utilized by cost category, allowing questions for clarification. Robert DeMarco assisted in explanations.
