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Walden Woods is a Common Interest Community. As such it is covered by Chapter 828 on the Connecticut General Statutes. A link to that law may be found at our website homepage.

Rental policy is covered in "the Act" and by our own governing documents. Mortgage providers are particularly interested in seeing that the rules for rentals are being followed.

You cannot rent your unit without following procedures. According to Section 1.1.5 of the RULES document, "All rentals..... require advance notice to and permission from the Conservancy and require owners to file copies of written leases with the Manager (Elite Management)."

And, according to Section 10.5 of our Declaration, "......to preserve the character of Walden Woods as originally established......all leases must be in writing and filed with the Association. Failure to so file will permit the Association to bring summary process against the tenant as a default in the lease in the name of its landlord............
No Unit Owner may lease any Unit which he or she owns until he or she receives a Permission to Lease."

At the April Conservancy Board Meeting, the Board reaffirmed that fines will be imposed for noncompliance of the rental policy. The complete policy is available at the website.
